QUILT SHOW CATEGORIES

2010 QUILT SHOW

The Quilt Show Committee has approved the following categories for the October 9-10, 2010 Quilt Show:

No size requirements. Designer, maker, and quilter to be named.

1. Pieced Bed Quilt - Any sized bed quilt that is primarily pieced.
2. Appliquéd Bed Quilt - Any sized bed quilt that is predominantly appliquéd, 50% or more, but sections may be pieced together.
3. Pieced Wall Hanging - Quilt made to be used as a decorative wall hanging that is primarily pieced.
4. Appliquéd Wall Hanging - Quilt made to be used as a decorative wall hanging that is at least 50% appliquéd, but sections can be pieced together.
5. Art Quilt - An original design that extends beyond traditional disciplines, using personal expressions and originality in design, colors, or technique.
6. Wearables - Garments
7. Other - Functional or decorative items such as purses, hats, scarves, totes, table runners, placemats & napkins, pillows, boxes, dolls or tree skirts, etc.

- * Members of Village Quilters will have the opportunity to vote for their choice in each of the above categories, plus 'Viewer's Choice'.
- * First and second place ribbons will be awarded based on member votes.
- * An attendance check-off sheet will be used when the voting card is given to each member.

- * Voting can take place on Saturday, October 9, at any time and on Sunday, October 10, ONLY BEFORE the show opens so that ribbons can be placed on the winning quilts before the show opens.

- * The 'Viewer's Choice' will be the only category selected by the public.
