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Wallet Supply List

1/3 yard focus fabric	marker that shows up on your fabric
1/3 yard lining	sewing machine zipper foot
½ yard for binding	Elmer's glue, or Sewline glue stick
7" zipper	general sewing supplies
5 inches of ¾ inch Velcro	rotary cutter and ruler
¼ yard of lite fusible web	

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: please cut the following pieces before class. Call or email if you have any questions.

Place focus and lining fabric right sides together.

First cut: Cut off selvages. Cut 8 7/8" off one short end. From the 8 7/8" piece of FOCUS fabric, cut one 8 7/8" X 8 ¼ " rectangle.

Second cut: With fabrics still right sides together, cut a 4" lengthwise piece (approx. 4" X 34"). From this piece cut two 5 3/8" pieces and ten 2" pieces.

Third cut: From the remaining piece of fabric, still right sides together (approx. 11" X 32"), cut a 5 7/8" strip. Then cut one 12 ¼ piece, one 1 ¾ piece, one 4" piece, and one 8 7/8" piece. Trim the 8 7/8" piece to 5 3/8 X 8 7/8".

Binding: You can make your own binding using ½ yard fabric cut into 2 ¼ inch bias strips. You will need approximately 150 inches. You do not need to stitch the bias strips together. OR you can purchase 4 yards of narrow, double-fold bias binding.

There is a \$6 fee for the pattern which will be handed out in class.
