

DESIGN PRINCIPLES OF MODERN QUILTING

Modern quilters use some (**but not ALL**) of these design elements in a modern/contemporary quilt. We **select** which design principles we want to **explore** in each quilt we make.

- Asymmetry & Alternative Grids
 - Simplicity and Minimalism
 - Negative Space
 - Bold Contrast
 - Improvisation
 - Modern Traditionalism--
Reinterpretations of the Past
 - Bold Graphics in Print Fabrics
(including modern batiks)
 - Low Volume Modern Prints
 - Modern Color Palettes
 - Exaggerated Scale (large or
small)
 - Infinite Edge [faced binding and
no borders]
- *****And remember **that NEW Ideas**
are emerging every day: Maximalism
and AfroModern are examples
