

VILLAGE QUILTERS WORKSHOP

Thursday, April 16, 2020

TRAPUNTO BY MACHINE

Workshop Description:

In this workshop you will learn a trapunto method you can do completely by machine, without cutting holes in the back of your quilt to stuff selected motifs. Machine stippling techniques will enhance your machine trapunto project.

Tools and Supplies:

Sewing Machine, in good working order, one that allows you to drop feed dogs

Darning or quilting foot for free-motion quilting

Needles: 80/12 Sharp

Optional - 70/10 only for using water-soluble thread (80/12 also works)

Thread, 50 weight (to match your background)

Water soluble marking pen

Water soluble basting thread (such as Wash-A-Way™)

Blunt-end scissors (for cutting away trapunto batt)

Safety Pins for pin basting

Fabric: Fabric for Top and Backing (our project requires a 15" square background, 3½" borders, and a 23" square for backing)

Batting: * Polyester or Wool batting for trapunto (such as Fairfield's

Traditional® or Quilter's Dream® Select Poly)

I will be bringing wool batting, so you don't have to buy any.

* Cotton or cotton/blend batting for final quilting
