



## Star Table Runner

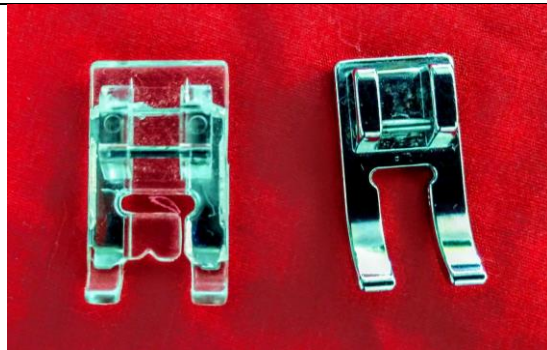
(12" x 40" runner)

For those of you who have seen appliqué pieces but have never tried appliqué or specifically fusible web machine appliqué, this class is for you! It can be a satisfying form of appliqué quilting which may be easier than you think!

### Class Supplies

- Piecing thread and thread to match the binding. Thread (white and red) to match the 2 star appliquéés
- Sewing kit including hand needles, extra bobbins, and sewing machine needles
- Sewing machine in working order, tool box, manual, foot pedal, power cord.
- Walking foot if you have one for your machine, regular  $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot, and embroidery foot or clear foot for appliqué
- When you go to choose the fabrics below, also buy **Heat n Bond Lite** fusible; however, I will bring squares for everyone if you can't find it at Joann, Michaels, Walmart, or other sewing and craft stores

Machine feet for appliqué- clear or an embroidery foot.to see what you are sewing. (\*\*Check online)

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

(12" X 40" runner)

1/6 yard red or blue fabric

1/6 yard multi print red/white/blue

OR

12 (6") squares of multi red, white, blue prints/solids

1/3 yard of background fabric

1/4 yard binding fabric

3/8 yard of backing fabric

17"x25" piece of Heat n' Bond Lite-small package

13" x 42" piece of batting

For all of these except multiprints, I went to my stash and scraps
