Blocks: Snowball plus 54-40 or Fight

9" finished block

Lap-17 Snowball Blocks and 18 54-40 or Fight Blocks

Wall Hanging-4 Snowball Blocks and 5 54-40 or Fight Blocks

Yardage:

Lap-59" x 77" 18 54-40 or Flight Blocks and 17 Snowball Blocks

Background 2 yards

Star background $\frac{2}{3}$ yard

Star points $\frac{7}{8}$ yard

Star center $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Four-patch $\frac{1}{2}$ yard

Snowball corners $\frac{3}{4}$ yard

Wallhanging-41" x 41" 5 54-40 or Fight Blocks and 4 Snowball Blocks

Background $\frac{1}{2}$ yard

Star background $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Star points $\frac{1}{3}$ yard

Star center $\frac{1}{8}$ yard

Four-patch $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Snowball corners $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Cutting-

Snowball Block:

Center-Cut $9\frac{1}{2}$ " square

Corners-Cut four $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square

54-40 or Fight Block:

4-patch-Cut two contrasting strips 2"-sew right sides together and crosscut eight 2" pieces

Center-Cut square $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

Peaky/Spike-Use Creative Grid Ruler (CGR2P1) or Marti Michell Ruler to cut a 3" finished Peaky/Spike patch-or you can paper piece (I will bring rulers and a paper piece pattern to class)

Four snowball block and Five 54-40 or Fight blocks will start the illusion of a curve.
