

TRIANGLE FRENZY RUNNER

This is an easy table runner that is made using a **BORDER STRIPE FABRIC**. Please note that this is not just any striped fabric. Several examples are shown on the website and at the workshop table. Please ask for assistance if you are not sure if a fabric is suitable. Your local quilt shop has many beautiful border stripes and they can assist you.

The size of the runner is determined by the size you cut your triangle. Therefore, the fabric amounts given below are approximate.

Pattern purchase is required: **TRIANGLE FRENZY RUNNER** BY Bonnie Cleland. It is available at most shops and online as a printed pattern or download.

FABRIC REQUIREMENT

Border stripe fabric with four repeats across the width of the fabric: **1 yard**. For fussy cutting you may want to purchase **2 yards**. The extra can usually be used to make a smaller table topper.

Backing: a coordinate is a good choice and can make your runner reversible. You will need about **1 ½ yards**

Batting

SUPPLIES:

Basic sewing supplies and a machine in good working order.

60 DEGREE TRIANGLE RULER: A BLUNT TIP IS PREFERRED

Rotary cutter and mat
